**Study** at Japan's comprehensive research university

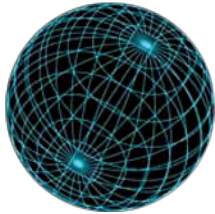
**Enjoy** social and cultural activities with ISP participants from other universities and students in Osaka University

**Learn** about Japanese culture and society

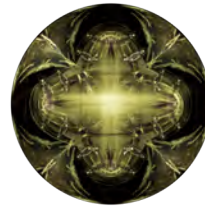

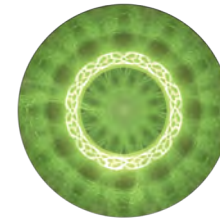

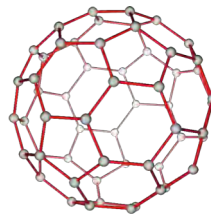

# Graduate School of Science

## AT A GLANCE

---

(As of 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2019)

- **2,075** students ( undergraduate: 1,146; graduate: 929)
- **212** international students from 32 countries
- **236** academic staff and **58** administrative staff
- **US\$ 20 million** annual budget (excluding salary)
- **+600** publications a year (2013-2017)\*

\* The Graduate School of Science overall average **FWCI= 1.6** (world average = 1). FWCI: Field-Weighted Citation Impact

\* 48.3 % International Collaboration (publications being co-authored with researchers in other countries)

## Course & Credits

Course: Frontier Lab Mini 4

Four Credits ( = 7.2 ECTS Equivalent) at Osaka University

## Fees

Tuition\*: 57,600 JPY

Accommodation (on-campus): 13,000~20,000 JPY per month

Travelling and living expenses: At the participant's expense

\*The tuition fee is exempted for partner university student.

## Scholarship

A limited number of qualified students will receive a JASSO (Japan Student Services Organization) Scholarship (80,000 JPY per month)

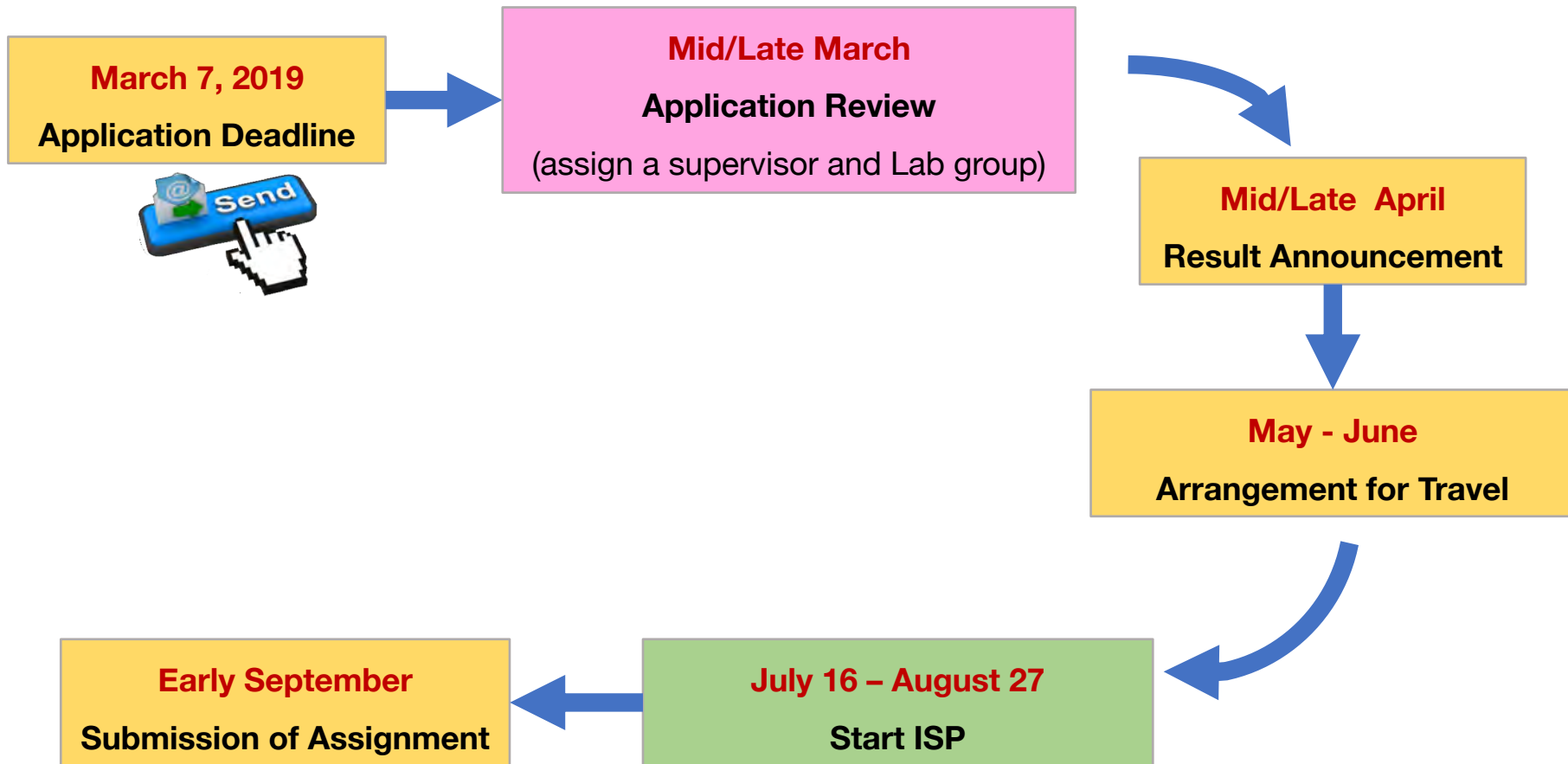
