紹介

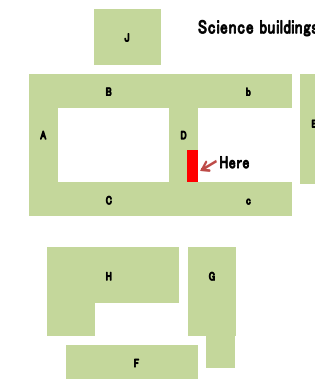
