How to calculate GPA;

- Score each subject you have taken within the past one year, with the table below.
 Multiply the point value by the number of credits. The result is the quality points (grade points) earned for the course.
- 2. Total the quality points for all subjects.
- 3. Total the credits for all subjects.
- 4. Divide the total quality points for all subjects by the total credits for all subjects.
- 5. The result is your cumulative GPA.

★Point value of Scores

Point value	Score
4	90-100
3	80-89
2	70-79
1	60-69

Example:

Step 1:

Score 90 (4) x 2 credit hours = 8.0 quality points

Score 85 (3) x 2 credit hours = 6.0 quality points

Score 70 (2) x 4 credit hours = 8.0 quality points

Step 2:

Total quality points = 22.0

Step 3:

Total credit hours = 8

Step 4:

22.0 / 8 = 2.75 cumulative GPA
