Live Streaming: You will just watch Zoom sessions. You cannot ask questions.

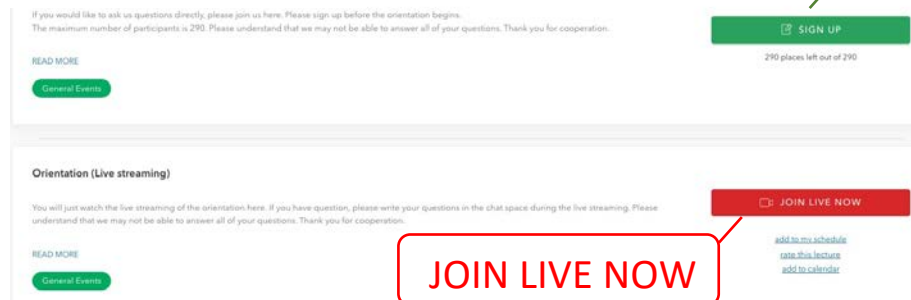
