Frequently Asked Questions

1. Are there any eligibility requirements for this program?

Answer)

Applicants must be enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's Degree program in universities outside of Japan during the program period.

This program is designed for overseas university students (undergraduate and master's students) who have sensitivity and intellectual curiosity about science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. Participating students will be assigned to one or several laboratories in the six departments including mathematics, physics, chemistry, biological sciences, macromolecular sciences, and earth and space science based on the application package. Therefore, applicants should be interested in working in laboratories in the Graduate School of Science.

2. I was not able to register during the registration period, can I still register?

Answer)

We only accept registrations that are submitted by the deadline: March 6, 2023 (JST).

3. Who is eligible for the scholarship?

Answer)

All the ISP participants, who tick "Yes" for "Section 3: Scholarship", are eligible for the nomination of the scholarship.

The nomination will be decided based on the screening of ISP application form. Those who passed the screening will be notified individually for further details.





4. Approximately how much is the scholarship?

Answer)

The details will be announced in the end of March 2023.

The stipend is expected to be about 70,000-80,000yen.

5. Am I exempt from ISP tuition fee?

Answer)

The tuition fee will be waived for students sent under the MOU for student exchange with the GSS, Osaka University.
